Agro On-Benjan-Kawasaki announces three-rider lineup for 2017 season



Agro On-Benjan-Kawasaki has finalized the team for the 2017 European Superstock 1000 campaign, with three riders lining up for the Dutch-based team as Toni Finsterbusch and Glenn Scott will join Wayne Tessels.



The 23-year-old Finsterbusch was runner-up in the German 125cc championship in 2010, has over 35 Moto3 and 125cc Grand Prix starts under his belt and knows how to be successful in motor racing as a multiple GP points-scorer. But luck wasn't on his side last year and therefor the German is motivated more than ever to be successful next year.



Australian Glenn Scott has raced in the World Supersport Championship in the last two years, but he suffered a compound fracture to his left tibia and a fracture to his left fibula after a low-side crash at Aragon in Spain in 2016. After his crash, Scott – 24 years old - has been doing everything physically possible to keep his dream alive and he can't wait to be back on track riding the fast Kawasaki.



Toni Finsterbusch: "I'm happy to join the team of Agro On-Benjan-Kawasaki. It's a great opportunity for me after the very difficult season in 2016. It looks like we will have a strong team and I can't wait to ride the new Kawasaki ZX-10RR for the first time during the winter test season.
